MTC PROGRAMS

Automotive Technology – You will learn to use state-of-the-art equipment in the diagnosis and repair of automobiles, while preparing for ASE Certification. Average salary**: \$14.60 per hour.

Carpentry – In this exciting program, students will build everything from a small shed to a full-size home! You will become skilled in the use of all the tools of the trade. Average salary**: \$11.20-\$13.60 per hour.

Collision Repair (11th/12th) - You will learn to refinish vehicles and restore older ones that may have been damaged due to age or collision. You will also learn the art of custom painting. Potential starting salary: \$9.00-\$10.00 per hour

Computer Repair A+*/Cisco Academy- This course provides students with the opportunity to develop skills needed to begin a career in building, installing, and troubleshooting computers. This course also includes several hardware and software topics needed to implement a basic network. Students will set up a server and do basic network trouble shooting. Students can become A+ Certified as well as Net+ certified. Potential starting salary: \$10.00-\$13.00 per hour.
Prerequisite/Requirement: Successful completion of 8th grade computer literacy course and/or keyboarding. *Possible Dual Enrollment with BRCC.

Cosmetology – This program provides theory & hands-on training in all phases of the profession. Upon satisfactory completion of this program, you will be prepared to take the State exam to become a licensed hair designer. Average salary**: \$10.95-\$13.80 per hour.

Criminal Justice – Federal agent? Police Officer? County Deputy? State Trooper? Come and see where you fit in a Criminal Justice career! You can earn college credits and get hands-on training! Average salary**: \$12.90-\$18.40 per hour.
Prerequisite/Requirement: Must be 16 years of age and verify by some form of photo identification by the 1st day of school.

Dental Assistant – Enter one of the fastest growing occupations in the nation. In this one year program, students will become skilled in using all instruments in a dentist office, as well as prepare for x-ray certification.

Diesel Truck Technology – You will cover a wide range of topics from diesel engine overhaul to preventative maintenance. You can prepare for the ASE Heavy Duty Truck Certification. Potential starting salary: \$7.00-\$18.00 per hour.

Drafting* – You will learn to engineer and design a house utilizing the industry-leading software “AutoCAD”. Be employed as soon as you graduate! Potential starting salary: \$10.00-\$12.00 per hour. *Possible Dual Enrollment with BRCC.

Electricity – Learn to design, install and maintain electrical systems for residential and commercial buildings. This class guarantees hands-on experience that is fun! Average salary**: \$17.50 per hour.

Fire and Rescue –In this program, students will be learning about the exciting field of public safety, including working closely with the area fire and rescue squad departments. Students will be trained in areas such as public safety, CPR, first aid, fire suppression techniques, and emergency management, while making a difference in their community. Area fire and rescue departments expect the need for volunteer and paid personnel to continue to increase as the Harrisonburg/Rockingham community grows in size. Salaries are predicted to remain competitive as well.
Prerequisite/Requirement: Must be 16 years of age and verify by some form of photo identification by the 1st day of school.

Health Careers (11th/12th) – Jump-start your career in the Health fields by taking this class. You can explore a variety of Health careers and then transfer to the MTC Practical Nursing program. This course prepares students seeking a CNA license. Potential starting salary: \$8.00 -\$14.00 per hour.
Prerequisite/Requirement~: Successful completion of biology prior to enrollment.

Heating & Air Conditioning Technology - You will learn the many aspects of this industry. Emphasis will be placed on the latest technology in residential & commercial heating/air conditioning systems & refrigeration systems. Potential starting salary: \$10.00-16.00 per hour

Masonry/Decorative Concrete – Masons lay the foundation for all we do. In addition to laying brick and block, instruction will be given in the most up-to-date decorative stamped concrete driveways and sidewalks and other decorative finishes such as “rock” and “slate” finishes. Average salary**: \$18.00 per hour.

Practical Nursing* (12th) – This program for seniors will prepare you for the most in-demand career in the health field today! Each student receives clinical experience and can earn credits toward BRCC RN program. Average salary**: \$15.00 per hour

Restaurant Careers (11th/12th) – You will experience the industry first hand by learning basic food preparation and presentation principles. Gain “real-world” experience by working in the MTC Café! Average salary**: \$8.30-\$16.65 per hour.

Robotics Technology* - This course will introduce the student to the basics of robotics & computer integrated manufacturing. The skills acquired in this course will prepare students for careers with businesses using automated manufacturing process. Potential starting salary: \$13.00-\$15.00 per hour. Students in this program are eligible for dual enrollment at an institution of higher education.*Possible Dual Enrollment with BRCC.

Veterinary Assistant* (11th/12th) – This program is an introductory course in the field of Veterinary Medicine. Students will explore various careers in Veterinary Science and learn specific skills as a veterinary assistant. This class teaches both smaller and some larger animal health care and how to assist the veterinarian with routine examinations, pet handling, feeding, and grooming. Potential starting salary: \$8.00-\$10.00 per hour.
Prerequisite/Requirement~: Successful completion of biology prior to enrollment. *Possible Dual Enrollment with BRCC.

Webmaster/Computer Animation- This one-year program teaches students how to design and produce their own web pages and graphics. Use your creativity coupled with instruction in web design and animation to enhance your career possibilities. Potential starting salary: \$10.00-\$12.00 per hour. *Prerequisite/Requirement*~: Successful completion of 8th grade computer literacy course and/or keyboarding.

Welding and Metalwork – In this class, you will learn layout, cutting, drilling, and welding techniques by completing hands-on projects. Students can work toward Welder Certification. Potential starting salary: \$9.00-\$10.00 per hour

*Students may earn college credits at Blue Ridge Community College

All morning classes will follow the odd/even block schedule with the exception of PNI. Each odd/even course meets on alternating days and students successfully completing the first year will be awarded 1.5 credits toward graduation.

Please Note: All class offerings are contingent upon sufficient student enrollment. Check with your guidance office to confirm that the number of program credits will meet your graduation requirements. Students may discuss scheduling options for enrolling in odd/even programs. Some classes will have prerequisites and requirements and student transcripts may be reviewed to verify requirements. Upperclassman will be given priority in classes with limited space availability. Please see your guidance counselor for details.

(11th /12th) denotes classes that students must be a Junior or Senior to be considered for enrollment. Grade levels are based on total high school credits earned.
